Installation Instructions

(Fits: ATI Six Position Buttstocks)

Buttpad Installation

Point the firearm in a safe direction and place the safety in the "on" position. Next pull back the slide, and carefully inspect the chamber and magazine to be sure the shotgun is unloaded.

Step #1

Cut out the buttpad template below.

Note: If your ATI buttstock already has pre-drilled holes for buttpad installation, skip to step #7.

Step #2

Pull down the latch lever and slide the ATI buttstock and shotforce buttpad off, and away from the buffer tube.

Step #3

Place the buttpad template onto the buttstock and secure the template to the buttstock with tape.

NOTE: Make sure the paper template is aligned perfectly with the outside profile of the buttstock. If the template is not aligned correctly, the buttpad will not correctly assemble to the stock.

Step #4

With the template secured to the buttstock, use a 1/4" drill bit to drill 2 straight holes on each side of the buttstock. Use the designated "X" in circles on the template as markers for these 2 holes.

NOTE: ATI is NOT responsible for broken drill bits

Step #5

Using the circle on the template and the same 1/4" drill bit, drill the single hole on the bottom of the buttstock 1/8" deep.

NOTE: This hole will not be drilled through, you must only drill 1/8" into the buttstock. The best way to drill 1/8" is to measure 1/8" from the edge of the drill bit and then place tape at the 1/8" mark so you don't drill any deeper.

Place the buttpad on the rear of the buttstock and using a T-20 torx driver, install the (2) $8 \times 48-2 \times 1/2"$ plastite torx head screws until snug.
